Friday: (5 pm - 7 pm) - **Combination Knitting** \$40

There is NO "wrong" way to knit - or purl! Annie Modesitt will explain the three main methods of knitting used around the world and how trying a new style can broaden your knitting horizon.

Each student should bring: This is a lecture, not a hands on class, however students are welcomed to bring light colored worsted weight yarn, and needles to work well with yarn for practice in class.

Saturday: (10 am -1pm) – **Cable Mania (Cable Sanity?)** \$60

Cables are a mainstay of knitting, but the technique for knitting them WITHOUT cabling needles has eluded many expert knitters. Overcome your fear of cabling and at the same time learn a technique that is faster and easier than the standard technique which uses an extra needle to twist the yarn. Even if you're a beginning knitter, you can cable like an Irish Fisherman (or woman). Come prepared to knit!

Each student should bring: Light colored worsted weight yarn, and needles to work well with yarn.

(2pm - 5pm) - **New Directions in Knitting With Color** \$60

Colorwork is a wonderful thing, and so satisfying for a knitter! Don't be afraid, be bold and confident as you take up your needles - enjoy the full range of colored yarns that are all around you. In this class we will learn how to "read" a colorwork chart and learn the basics of changing colors in a row while knitting. We will also discuss the differences between fair isle and intarsia, and compare different methods of carrying yarn across the back of the work. Come prepared to knit!

Each student should bring: Several colors of light colored worsted weight yarn, and needles to work well with yarn.

Sunday: (11am - 2pm) **Tips & Tricks** \$60

A potpourri of knitting tips, tricks, hints and lots of fun stuff! We'll do some bobbles, some i-cord, some cabling and along the way learn tricks for starting new yarn, casting on, binding off, and other fun stuff.

Each student should bring: Light colored worsted weight yarn, needles to work well with yarn.
